Subject: Airport Hot Topics

For your review, below is a listing of issues affecting the Chester County/G.O. Carlson Airport (MQS).

## NEW BUSINESS

\* **Pennsylvania Aviation & Aerospace Conference:** On September 22<sup>nd</sup> - 24<sup>th</sup>, I attended this conference, which was held in Pocono Manor, PA. The General Sessions that I attended included: 1) Dynamic Planning and Revenue Enhancement, 2) PA Bureau Aviation Updates and 3) Federal and State Updates.

\* **East Drive-thru Gate Repaired:** On September 30<sup>th</sup>, an electric eye gate sensor was installed, due to a damaged gate loop. At some point, a new loop will be replaced.

\* **Tree Removed:** Inclement weather (rain, strong winds) resulted in a tree falling down across Aviation Way during the morning hours on October 1<sup>st</sup>. The tree was cleared from the road by 6:15 am.

## OLD BUSINESS

\* **West Basin Project:** The stand pipe has been installed and the basin is functioning properly.

\* **Tree Cutting Project:** Approximately 30% of the tree branches (Runk Project) that were cut down and relocated on the other side of Ms. Runk's fence line (the south side of the airport), have been cut up. Eventually, the trees will be transported to the east end of the airport.

\* **Field Mower:** On 9/13/10, a new clutch was installed on the field mower.
